Who needs this qualification?

Anyone entering the workplace for the first time, either as part of a work experience programme or at the start of employment and those starting a new job (as part of an induction programme in food premises.)

Why is this training important?

Employers are legally responsible for providing health and safety training to their employees as appropriately required for their work duties.

This qualification provides a great starting point from which more detailed health and safety and / or food safety training (e.g. CIEH Level 2 Awards) can follow.

- Identify the range of hazards associated with food premises and understand how to spot them
- Understand the role of reporting procedures
- Understand the importance of risk control measures in place and identify ways to reduce risks or eliminates hazards
